## EXPLANATION OF CVSA CHAMPIONSHIP CHARGES AT WOY WOY PLC.

Coast and Valley have been trying to negotiate a better deal with PLC & Gosford Council for pool entry for swimmers and spectators. This was bought about as a result of a lot of complaints from families, over the past 2 years, regarding the cost of entry into the Woy Woy PLC.

The best two options were voted on by club delegates at the CVSA AGM 21/6/2015.

The following charges will apply at Summer Championships 2015.

**Entry fees; \$20 per swimmer = Meet Fee**

and

\$6 per individual event

E.g.; 1 swimmer enters 10 events @ \$6 per event = \$60 entry fees + \$20 meet fee = \$80 Total

**MEET FEE** entitles **ALL** family members and friends **FREE** unlimited entry to PLC and should alleviate the line up to enter the complex.

**Meet fee** = \$20 per swimmer and is capped at 2 swimmers per family **maximum = \$40**.

If you have more than 2 swimmers you will have to pay \$20 for each swimmer in your family to enter the meet, **BUT** you will get \$20 refund for every swimmer in the family after the first two by CVSA.

If you have a swimmer who is only a relay swimmers there will be **NO** charge

The pool entry fee at for the 2015 Winter Championships was **\$5.30**. CVSA have been informed by PLC management that the pool entry fee will increase to **\$5.60** at 1st July 2015 and increase to **\$5.90** at 1st July 2016.

Competition in the pool was high class and for many athletes a great lead up to NSW Country and State Age and Open Championships in July and August.

The nine years and under age group was dominated by Hunter duo Kelsey Van Eldik and Heidi Schneider in the girls who both doubled their nearest rivals. In the boys Ryan Vesper from Mingara dominated all events.

The ten years age group was well contested in the boys between Tyne Spencer of KPD and Charles Walker of Hunter. The girls division was dominated by Hunter swimmers Emily March and Averil Jones.

The eleven years age group was dominated by Hunter competitor Cassandra Fayers. She was followed up by Christine Connell of Novocastrian and Eden Matterson of KPD. In the boys the competition was completely dominated by Riley Mather of Nelson Bay who doubled the point score of his nearest rivals.

The twelve year age group was dominated by Emily Jones of Novocastrian and Kaylah Holmes of Woy Woy. The boys division was won by Logan Black of Titans with Daniel Taylor of West Wallsend Indoor finishing in second place.

The thirteen years age group was dominated by Macquarie Shores competitor Jasmine Anderson who was closely followed by Claudia Yates of Hunter Valley Allstars. The boys division was dominated by Zane Morphew-Watson of Nelson Bay followed by Ryan Walker of Macquarie Shores.
