**6. GENERAL BUSINESS**

**6.1 Review of 2018 Development Activities – (see attached CVSA Area Development report for financial details)**

**6.1.1 CVSA Development Days**

Our 2018 CVSA Development Squad days at The Forum were delivered in age groups rather than Development squad groups. We delivered the Development Program over two days, having two groups in on the same day and utilising presenters to do multiple presentations on one day. The younger groups were in attendance on this day and reducing the pool sets to two hour sessions for these swimmers was much more appropriate, with the older swimmers they enjoyed four hours in the pool:

- **23<sup>rd</sup> June, 13 yrs & Over,** (51 swimmers). The education sessions delivered on this day were Physio / stretching, Strength and Conditioning, Nutrition, Sports Psychology and Beyond the Black Line Program from Australian Swimmers Association. The presentations were followed by pool training sets for the afternoon.
- **1<sup>st</sup> July for 10yrs and Under,** (33 swimmers). The education sessions delivered on this day were Physio / stretching, Strength and Conditioning, Nutrition and Social Media. The presentations were followed by pool training sets for the afternoon with guest coach Simon Watkins from Trinity Lismore attending as a Mentor Coach for this development weekend.
- **1<sup>st</sup> July for 11 – 12 yrs.** (46 swimmers). The education sessions delivered on this day were Sports Psychology, Strength and Conditioning, Nutrition and Social Media. The presentations were followed by pool training sets for the afternoon with guest coach Simon Watkins from Trinity Lismore attending as a Mentor Coach for this development weekend.

The delivery of the Development Day Education sessions would not be possible without the generous assistance of our presenters. The Strength and Condition sessions were run by Shaun and Yvette from Strength Republic, <https://www.strengthrepublic.com.au/#our-story>. The Nutrition sessions were delivered by, Jason Varoxis from Enliven Nutrition, <https://enlivennutrition.com>. The Social Media sessions were presented by Senior Constable Brett Rose, the Youth Liaison Officer for Newcastle Police District. The Beyond the Black Line program was delivered by Kurt Herzog from the Australian Swimmers association. The Physio / stretching sessions were run by Craig Boettcher from Regant Street Physio and the Sports Psychology sessions were delivered by Fiona McCarthy of Mind and Body Balance.

### 6.2 **Development Activities and selection criteria Planning for 2019.**

**For swimmers to be eligible to participate in CVSA Development Squads they MUST:**

- **Have competed in an individual event at 2018 SC or LC Area Championships:**
- **Be a current financial member of NSW**
- **Be an Australian resident permanently training in the CVSA area**



### 6.2.1 National A

- Swimmers 13 – 18 years who compete in an individual event at 2019
- Swimmers 18+ years may be considered as camp mentors
- Australian age or National Open water (*JX swimmers not considered for National A squad*)
- All swimmers who qualify are invited to attend aged development days, but this will not be compulsory.
- Nat A camp 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Oct at Port Stephens – booked for 70 participants (squad members from other Areas may participate). Deposit has been paid.
- **Uniform- consider one uniform for all Areas attending the camp.**
- Fee payable by CVSA swimmers to be decided.
- Limit number to 20 or 30 for CVSA depending on availability of accommodation
- 2020 Gold Coast camp has been approved by Management Committee

### 6.2.2 Senior Area Representative Squad

- Swimmers aged 13-18yrs who competed in an individual event at 2018/19 Long Course State or Country Champs
- Senior Area Meet 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2019
- Consider Accommodation for state swimmers/bus each day/other – dependant on final team makeup.
- Age up on date of Development Meet
- Team Manager to be appointed.

### 6.2.3 Junior Area Representative Squad

- Swimmers aged 10-12yrs who competed in an individual event at 2018/19 Long Course State or Country Champs
- Junior Area Meet 12<sup>th</sup> Oct 2019, at SOPAC
- Age up on date of Development Meet
- Bus needed for swimmers
- Moved Phil Hawke 2<sup>nd</sup> Blinda Francis-Smith that buses tentatively book and quotation obtained. Carried. Recommendation to be taken to Management.
- Team Manager to be appointed

- Cost of hire of facilities to be determined.

- Initial criteria for 9-16yrs however flexible to let swimmers from 7yrs in on provision they understand if too little to handle baskets then just sit with team and watch meet.
- Bus booked and Parents offered seats on bus at \$10 each if spare seats available.
- Junior Squad is about encouraging participation in swimming. Make squad fun and encourage parents to continue swimmer's participation in future squads.

- Confirm with Michael Hyslop swim activity 3.00pm-3.30pm (1/2 hour program)
- No activity planned for Senior Est Squad.

### 6.3 Development Days

- Age group delivery of content, 13-18yrs, 11-12yrs, 10&U
- Two days again with younger groups on one day giving each group 2 hours in pool?
- Possibly look at running on one weekend and try and get pool time on Sunday morning, with guest coach utilised Saturday afternoon / Sunday Morning.
- Pay guest coach, accommodation cost, travel expenses? Budget for guest coach to be set: say \$1500. Recommendation to Management.
- Last year Physio took swimmers up to an empty gym room at The forum. Costs for booking room or utilising Gym spaces to be ascertained by Phil Hawke.
- Presenters to be organised for each development day
- Presentations may include Beyond the Black Line (for girls), Nutrition (Jason Varoxis), Social Media Hunter Life/Police Liaison, Physio(Brett Doring/Craig Boettcher), Kinesiology for swimmers.

- Publish a list of all swimmers who will be eligible for invitations to CVSA development squads. Initial list of swimmers who competed at CVSA Champs would be sent out to all clubs informing these swimmers will be eligible for Dev Squads and send General info sheets out. Target for this would be end of March for this to be completed and sent. See attached info sheets to be sent out.
- All Squad specific invitations to be sent out at the same time in mid May.
- Invitation letter will have link to online payment and online application form. This worked well in past so I recommend it is continued in 2019. Russell sets up individual squad meets which has Squad payment fee.
- Recommend that squad fee for 2019 be \$40 for all squads and additional camp fee for National A – to be decided once all costings for camp are available.
